



TRAVEL & COSTS

Average trip cost: \$1,950 + airfare

- 1st Payment: \$2,000 deposit before flights can be booked
- 2nd Payment: Remaining balance due 30 days prior to departure date

Extra Costs:

- **\$400+ for a safari, based on group size**
- Kenya Visa (\$51) and Tanzania Visa (\$100)
- Tips for any staff members given at the end of the trip
- Meals and snacks during travel or optional outings
- Spending money for souvenirs, gifts, or any fun items
- Passport if you do not have a valid one
- Travel vaccinations and COVID-19 testing (if required)



VISAS & PASSPORT

You must have a valid passport to travel and it must **not expire within six months of your departure**, or you will not be allowed to leave the US. You will also need four empty pages in your passport book.

Cash and Card Rules:

- All cash must be in bills that are newer than 2009. Larger bills such as \$100 or \$50 get the best exchange rate.
- Notify your bank of your travel plans so your cards will not be locked due to use in foreign countries. Only use your cards is necessary due to international fees and theft.
